Only cash and cheques are accepted at the Uniform Shop.

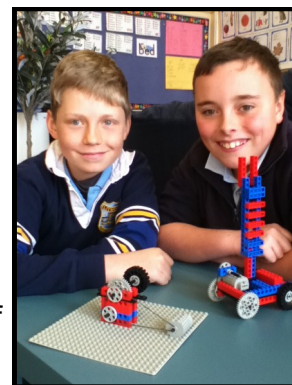
MYSTERY READER
